We do not use cookies to deliberately collect sensitive personal information about our beneficiaries.

You can control or delete cookies through your browser settings. You can also choose whether to accept non-essential cookies where a cookie consent option is provided on our website.

Some services or features on our website may be provided by third parties and may place their own cookies on your device. Their use of cookies is subject to their own privacy policies.
